WHO WE ARE

SOS Children's Villages is a global federation working primarily to provide protection, quality care and a loving home to the children who have lost or are at the verge of losing parental care. The first SOS Children's Village was established by Prof. Hermann Gmeiner in 1949 after the World War II in Imst, Austria. Since then, we have evolved in 136 countries and territories around the world. In Nepal, the first SOS Children's Village was established in 1972 in Sanothimi as a non-governmental organization and currently, we are present in 43 programme locations*.

PROGRAMMES

ALTERNATIVE CARE

Family Like Care

Through this programme, children live together with an SOS mother, brothers and sisters in a loving family. They receive an individualized care, support and quality education. Children with biological siblings are raised together.

Youth Care

SOS Youth Care offers a stepping-stone to independence to the young people generally after they complete Secondary Education Examination (SEE). We support the young people as they learn to take responsibility of their own actions, their college work, household tasks, and managing finance. Our support is tailored as per their specific needs and best interests.

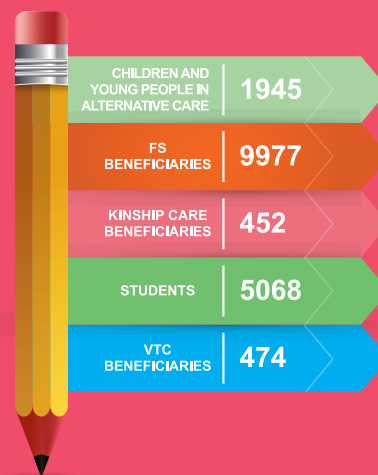


FAMILY STRENGTHENING

We work jointly with families and communities to strengthen their capacities to provide quality care and protection for their children in cooperation with local authorities and other service providers. We provide education, health care, livelihood support, social support, and psychological support as per the need of the families. SOS Social Centres are running along with this programme to strengthen the families and communities.

Kinship Care

We support children without parental care to live with their relatives as per the child's and the relatives' interest providing them access to basic health care facilities and quality education. In addition, we support the families to become self-reliant through Family Strengthening (FS) programme.



EDUCATION AND TRAINING

SOS Hermann Gmeiner Schools, often regarded as model schools in the respective locations, follow the National Curriculum of Government of Nepal. Through our educational programme, we seek to mold the students into globally competitive and socially responsible individuals.

SOS Vocational Training Centre (VTC) provides vocational training to the young people from SOS programmes and nearby communities giving them an opportunity to equip themselves with the qualifications and skills required to secure a reliable employment.

CHILD SAFEGUARDING AND ADVOCACY

SOS Children's Villages has adopted zero tolerance policy regarding abuse, neglect, violence and exploitation of children. Our approach to Child Safeguarding is guided by Child Protection Policy: *Child Safety is Everybody's Business*.

Our advocacy work is designed to influence national policies for the rights of children without parental care and children at the risk of losing such care. We ensure participation of children in decision-making processes that affect their lives.
