Section I. Invitation for Catalogue Shopping (ICS)

1. The *SOS Children's Villages Nepal* invites proposals for the procurement of 4WD SUV vehicle as detailed in attached Specifications and the Schedule of Requirements provided herein.
2. The Proposal submitted by the Bidder shall comprise the following:
 - a. Quotation and Price Schedules
 - b. Schedule of Requirements
 - c. Technical Specifications
 - d. Detail Catalogue
3. Proposals must be submitted to the office of **SOS Children's Villages Nepal, National Office, Sanothimi, Bhaktapur**, before **April 9, 2026, at 12:00 pm**.
4. The Bidder shall indicate on the Price Schedule the unit prices (where applicable) and total price of the goods to be supplied under the contract. All duties, taxes and other levies payable by the Supplier/Bidder under the contract shall be included in the rates, prices and total Bid Price submitted by the Bidder.
5. Price quoted by the Bidder shall remain fixed and valid until completion of the Contract Performance and will not be subject to variation in any account.
6. Submitted Priced Quotations must remain valid for a period of **15 days** after the deadline for submission date.
7. The Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, documents establishing the Supplier's/ Bidder's eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted. Documents to establish such eligibility shall be but not limited to the following:
 - a) Up to date Firm/Company Registration Certificate
 - b) VAT and PAN Registration Certificates
 - c) Tax Clearance Certificate of FY 2081/82
 - d) Manufacturer's Authorization Certificate
 - e) Other documents as needed
8. The goods supplied under this contract shall conform to the Schedule of Requirements and the standards mentioned in the Technical Specification.

Section II. Conditions of Contract

- 1. Definitions**
- 1.1 In this contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:
- a. "The Contract" means the agreement entered into between the Purchaser and the Supplier, as recorded in the Contract Form Signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein;
 - b. "The Contract Price" means the price payable to the Supplier under the contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligation;
 - c. "The Goods" means Equipment and related Accessories and spare-parts or any other materials which the Supplier is required to supply to the Purchaser under the contract;
 - d. "Services" means services ancillary to the supply of the goods such as transportation and insurance including the installation, commissioning and the operational and maintenance training of the supplied equipment.
 - e. "The Purchaser" means the procuring entity purchasing the goods;
 - f. "The Supplier" means the organization supplying the goods and services under this contract.
- 2. Technical Specification**
- 2.1 The goods supplied under this contract shall confirm to the standards mentioned in the Technical Specification.
- 3. Patent Right**
- 3.1 The Supplier shall indemnify the SOS Children's Villages Nepal against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark or industrial design rights arising from use of goods or any part thereof in the Purchaser's country.
- 4. Inspection and Tests**
- 4.1 The SOS Children's Villages Nepal or its Representative shall have the right to inspect and/or test the goods to confirm their conformity to the Technical Specification and the quality of performance after the supply and delivery of good to the Purchaser's premises.
- 5. Delivery of Goods**
- 5.1 Delivery of the goods shall be made by the Supplier in accordance with the terms specified by the SOS Children's Villages Nepal in its Schedule of Requirements.
- 6. Warranty**
- 6.1 The Supplier warrants that all the goods supplied under the contract shall fully comply with the specification laid down in the contract.

- 6.2 The warranty shall remain valid for one year after the goods have been delivered to the final destination indicated in the contract and accepted by the SOS Children's Villages Nepal after installation and commissioning of equipment by the Supplier.
- 6.3 The SOS Children's Villages Nepal shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty.
- 6.4 Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, with all reasonable speed, replace the defective goods without cost to the SOS Children's Villages Nepal. The Supplier will be entitled to remove, at its own risk and cost, the defective goods.
- 7. Payment**
- 7.1 Payment of the goods supplied shall be made in Nepali Rupees after the delivery and installation and commissioning of goods to the satisfaction of the SOS Children's Villages Nepal.
- 7.2 Payment shall be made within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the goods and upon submission of claim supported by the acceptance certificate issued by the SOS Children's Villages Nepal.
- 8. Prices**
- 8.1 Prices charged by the Supplier for goods delivered under the contract shall not vary from the prices quoted by the Supplier in the proposal.
- 9. Governing Language**
- 9.1 The Governing Language shall be: Nepali or English
- 10. Applicable Law**
- 10.1 The applicable law shall be Laws of Nepal.
- 11. Notices**
- 11.1 Purchaser's address for notice purposes: Madhyapur Thimi – 2, Sanothimi, Bhaktapur
- 11.2 Supplier's address for notice purposes:
- 12. Taxes and Duties**
- 12.1 The Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, licence fees and other such levies imposed by the GoN.
- 13. Operation, Maintenance and Spare-parts Manuals**
- 13.1 The successful Supplier shall supply 2 copies of manufacturer's operation, maintenance and spare-part manuals of the goods (Equipment).
- 14. Conduct of Suppliers**
- 14.1 The Supplier shall be responsible to fulfil his obligations as per the requirement of the Contract Agreement, Bidding documents.
- 14.2 The Supplier shall not carry out or cause to carry out the following acts with an intention to influence the implementation of the procurement process or the procurement agreement:

- a. Give or propose improper inducement directly or indirectly,
- b. Distortion or misrepresentation of facts
- c. Engaging or being involved in corrupt or fraudulent practice
- d. Interference in participation of other prospective bidders.
- e. Coercion or threatening directly or indirectly to impair or harm, any party or the property of the party involved in the procurement proceedings,
- f. Collusive practice among bidders before or after submission of bids for distribution of works among bidders or fixing artificial/uncompetitive bid price with an intention to deprive the SOS Children's Villages Nepal the benefit of open competitive bid price.
- g. Contacting the SOS Children's Villages Nepal with an intention to influence the SOS Children's Villages Nepal with regards to the bid or interference of any kind in examination and evaluation of the bids during the period after opening of bids up to the notification of award of contract

15. Dispute Resolution

- 15.1 Any dispute arising out of the Contract, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties, shall be referred to adjudication.
